

**Withington Community Hospital** is located on Nell Lane, West Didsbury and can easily be accessed from the surrounding areas by foot, road and public transport.

### **Coming by car**

If you are using a satnav, enter postcode M20 2LW.

If you're travelling from the motorway, the nearest junction of the M60 is Junction 5. From here, head along the A5103 towards Manchester city centre. After passing the junction with the A5145, take the first turning on the right into Nell Lane. Withington Community Hospital is on the right just after Elizabeth Slinger Road.

If you're travelling from the city centre, take the A5103 towards Didsbury and the M56. Just before the junction with the A5145, take the first turning on the left into Nell Lane. Withington Community Hospital is on the right, just after Elizabeth Slinger Road.

The entrance to the carpark is off Nell Lane.

### **Metrolink**

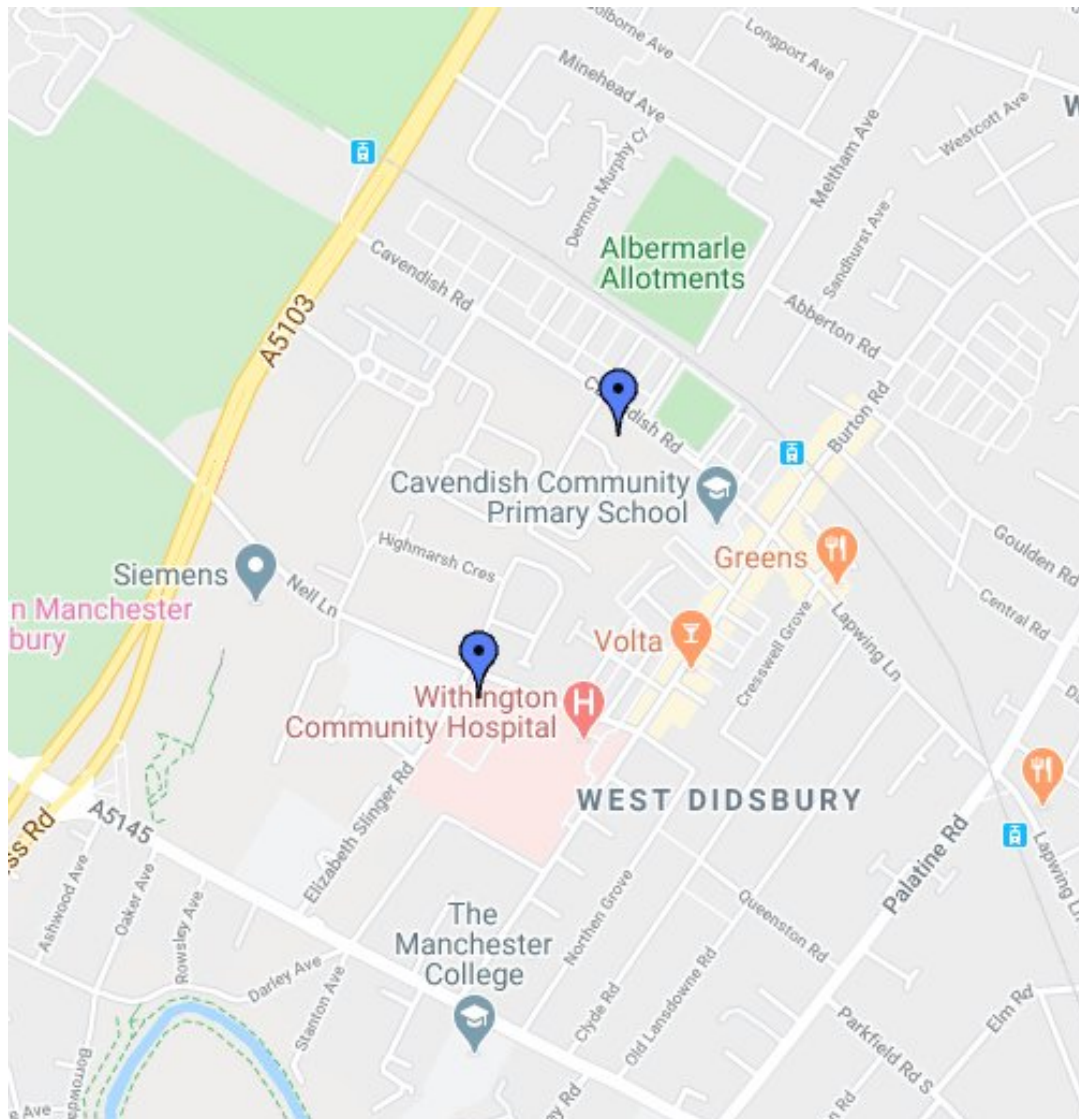
The nearest stop to Withington Community Hospital is **Burton Road**, a ten minute walk away from the hospital's main entrance.

### Walking and cycling

Withington Community Hospital is easily accessible on foot and is approximately 20 minutes' walk from Didsbury and around 25 minutes' walk from Chorlton.
